

## **Frequently Asked Questions**

- 1. How long will registration be open? Registration is open to the public beginning March 27 through May 19 unless spots fill up sooner. There is a limited number of spots available in each track. Tracks will show up as "Sold Out" if the track is full.
- 2. What ages may attend? Children currently in grades K-5 (scheduled to attend 1st through 6th grade in the Fall of 2019) may attend. If your child is in a formal, full-time transitional kindergarten school setting (not preschool) during the 2018-19 school year, they may register for a Level one track.
- 3. Will my child be able to participate in all three tracks? Our emphasis is connecting with the students in a particular area of interest. They will stay in the track they have registered. Our hope is that every kid will love the track they're in and want to come to our Saturday Night Life events to try another track!
- 4. What is Saturday Night Life? Saturday night life will be Life Summer Camp on a smaller scale, held on Saturday Nights 2-3 times throughout the year. Mark your calendars now for August 24, 2019 (Active), October 12, 2019 (Creative) and January 11, 2020 (Stem) from 5-7:30pm.
- 5. Will my child be able to switch to another track during the Life Summer Camp event? Children will stay in the track they have been registered, throughout the week.
- **6. Will my child be encouraged to invite friends to this event?** Your child is encouraged to invite friends to register BEFORE the event during open registration. Please feel free to text the link to our registration to invite friends. There will not be points given for inviting friends.
- 7. Who can volunteer? Volunteers can apply to serve by registering online. All volunteers are expected to hold to the same beliefs of Redwood Chapel as stated on our website and will be asked to share their testimony in brief on the application. By registering to serve, you are agreeing to our statement of faith. Volunteers under the age of 18 should register with a parent's approval (given in our registration). All volunteers will be expected to attend our volunteer training on June 14 at 5pm.
- 8. Will volunteers be background checked? All volunteers over the age of 18 will be background checked.
- **9. Is there childcare for volunteers?** Yes, limited childcare will be available. If you wish to serve and have children in the nursery preschool age, please register early on so we can ensure enough coverage. This will be childcare, and not a full-fledged program as in the past, at least for our first year. All volunteers must be background checked.

- 10. VBS was free, why does this event cost money? This event is different than VBS. Much of the cost per student is subsidized by those who have given financial gifts to offset the cost of Life Summer Camp. Our goal is to provide each child with quality, hands on experience in the tracks. The cost covers their t-shirt, and hands on experience and in some cases take-homes for the campers.
- **11. What if I cannot afford to send my kids?** Please contact us and let us know if you would like to set up partial payments. Registrations must be paid in full before children attend Life Summer Camp.
